Roll

The class roll is recorded as soon as school begins. If your child will be taking a significant period of time off due to a holiday or other family commitment please notify the school in writing as soon as possible **before** the absence. If your child arrives late, you need to go to the office and get a late note **before** bringing them down to the classroom. If you are picking your child up early a note needs to be collected from the office and given to the class teacher. The reason for the partial absence is also required to complete the roll.

Bus travel and student pick up

If your circumstances change, please provide in writing to myself what the new arrangements are. Please include where your child is travelling to and how they will be getting there.
