

## BOOK CHARACTER PARADE/BOOK FAIR

Grose View Public School's Book Week will be held in **Term 4 Week 3**. During this week, students will participate in our celebration of books through numerous activities related to the theme *Curious Creatures, Wild Minds*, which includes our Book Character Parade and Book Fair.



Due to current restrictions, this year our festivities will be held as closed, in-school events.

The Book Character Parade will be held on **Monday 26 October**, where students will traverse a path around the school. After the parade, we will be sharing photos and video of the parade with our community through Class Dojo and on our Facebook page.

Students are encouraged to wear their costume to school and throughout the day as we keep the celebration of books going, and awards will be given for creative and interesting costumes.

Our Book Fair will also be operating during Book Week. As this year it will be a cashless Fair without the ability for parents to visit, you will need to use Scholastic's online system to pay. Instructions on how to do this will be on the catalogue that will be distributed in the weeks leading up to the Book Fair, as well as on the back of student Wish Lists.

On **Friday 23 October**, during class time, students will visit the Book Fair to create a "Wish List" to take home.

Before **Monday 26 October**, photos of books and merchandise for sale with prices, will be posted online for parents to view.

From **Monday 26 to Wednesday 28 October**, before school and during class time, students will continue to be able to browse the Book Fair, and return their Wish Lists completed with receipt details to select their products.

Please make sure you clearly mark (eg highlight) which of the items on the Wish List you have paid for if there are specific items. If you wish to give your child an amount limit (eg \$25) for them to make their own choice, that is also possible. You may also wish to donate an amount for the purchase of books for the school library.

Please note that while books will be reordered if there is a demand, merchandise is sold by what is available on the day. If you pay for an item of merchandise that should run out of stock, students will be asked to select alternative item/s to the same value.
