The walk-a-thon course is 20 laps. During the course, all students will have the opportunity to participate in a number of activities run by Year 6 such as the Haunted Hall, Soccer Smash Down and Magical Music Statues. These activities will abide by strict COVID-19 guidelines. Please note that some activities will involve spraying students with a light spray with water. Please contact your child's teacher if you prefer your child is not sprayed.
