



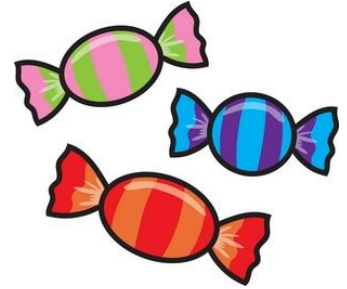

## **YEAR 6 PYJAMA MUFTI DAY and GUESSING COMPETITION**

Our Year 6 students are very excited to be organising a pyjama mufti day and guessing competition as their first fundraiser for 2020.

Each year, our Year 6 students raise funds to put towards purchasing a special contribution to the school. Last year, our 2019 Year 6 students purchased a 3D printer.

We are very mindful that many families may be experiencing financial stress due to the unprecedented circumstances experienced throughout this year. Please note that all fundraising efforts are voluntary.

On Tuesday 18 August, students are invited to wear their pyjamas to school. A monetary donation would be much appreciated on this day, however, a donation is not compulsory. Students will need to wear their school shoes with their pyjamas for safety reasons.

During the week leading up to the mufti day, Year 6 will be holding a Kindy-Year 2 and Year 3-Year 6 guessing competition.
