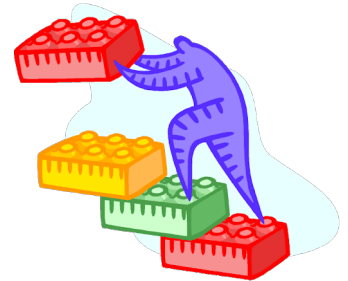

SRC LEGO BUILDING COMPETITION

Our SRC students have organised a fun-filled Lego building competition as part of their morale boosting efforts. All students are encouraged to participate and may team up with siblings or friends in order to construct their entry. The event includes an in-school competitive final, which will take place during this year's Talent Quest.

Event:	SRC Lego Building Competition
Final Entry Date:	Tuesday 8 December 2020
Entry Requirements:	Photographs are to be submitted online via email or through class dojo
Entry Cost:	Free entry
Theme:	Free choice design



To participate, students are able to construct any design of their choice. There is no limit on the number of bricks allowed and designs may be freehand or constructed from a specific set. Judging will be completed by fellow students on the basis of difficulty, innovation and aesthetic appearance. A select number of students who are voted for by their peers will be selected to participate in the final during the Talent Quest, where they will compete in a time limited building challenge.

Students may enter the competition individually or as a member of a group. Judging will take place in Stage groups. If a group of students includes members who are from different Stage groups (eg a Year 1 student and a Year 6 student) then they will be entered in the Stage group of their oldest member.

Entries can be submitted through sending a picture via class dojo to your child's teacher or as an attachment in an email to Mr Chenery (matthew.chenery@det.nsw.edu.au) or Mrs Stone (jennifer.cornish@det.nsw.edu.au).

We ask that all picture entries follow the guidelines listed below:

- There is no set theme for the construction. Designs may be as intricate or expansive as you like.
- Please do not bring your design in to school. Entries are by photograph only. If you cannot submit your entry via photograph please contact Mr Chenery or Mrs Stone.
- Multiple pictures of the same construction (eg top, side and front view) can be included, and are encouraged.
- At least one picture must include any/all of the students who helped in the construction, with the design visible in the background.
- There is a limit of one entry per student.
