COVID INTENSIVE LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM – NUMERACY

This year the NSW government has introduced a COVID Intensive Learning Support Program to ensure that student learning is supported following the disruptions experienced in 2020. At Grose View Public School we will be providing small-group tuition focusing on core content and skills in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy.

Small group tuition is an effective way of helping children consolidate key skills in areas where they may have fallen behind. It also extends their understanding and provides an opportunity for them to practise skills and gain independence.

In consultation with your child's teacher we feel that your child would benefit from attending these additional Numeracy sessions.

There will be 4 x 30 minutes sessions each week covering the core aspects of number, including place value, addition and subtraction. Your child's progress will be regularly checked and monitored.

It is important that your child attends school every day and arrives at school on time.
