NATIONAL YOUNG LEADERS DAY 2022

Your child has the opportunity as part of the Student Executive Team to attend the National Young Leaders Day held at the International Convention Centre, Darling Harbour on **Tuesday 8 March 2022**.

The National Young Leaders Day is a national event founded in 1997 to develop strong leadership values amongst young Australians. The program consists of keynote speakers, multimedia presentations and interactive learning that seeks a range of specific outcomes for young people who aspire to lead themselves and others well. Some of the speakers addressing the students on the day include Lachie Smart (youngest pilot to fly solo around the world), Bronte Campbell (swimming superstar) and Josh Pyke (ARIA award winning musician and author).

Mrs Lavender and Mr Carter will be accompanying the children on this excursion. Transport to and from this event will be with Mrs Lavender and Mr Carter by train. Students will need an Opal card for this excursion organised before the day by parents, with a minimum amount of \$15 available for the return fare. A school bus Opal card is only for travel between home and school, thus it **will not** be accepted for this event. Children will need to be at Richmond Train Station by 6.30 am.

There is no cost for the program other than the train fare. Grose View will cover the fee of the Leaders Day. Children may bring a small amount of spending money if they wish.

Children will need to be in **full school uniform including the Grose View blazer**, which will be handed out the day prior to the event.

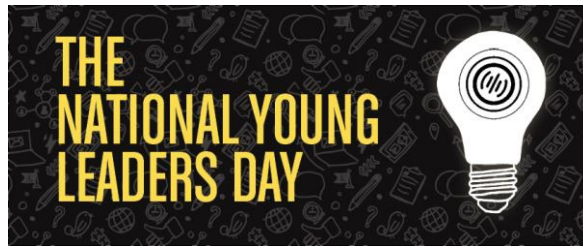

- Train tickets - \$3.44 per child and \$6.89 adult Opal single trip
- Parents to organise Opal card prior to event
- Meet at Richmond station at 6.30 am
- Train leaves at 6.41 am
- Arrive Town Hall station at 8.02 am
- Walk to International Convention Centre Darling Harbour
- Expo doors open at 8.45 am
 - 9.15 am with Session 1
 - 10.30 am: Morning Tea
 - 11.10 am: Session 2
 - 12.45 pm: Lunch
 - 1.25 pm: Session 3
 - 2.30 pm: Finish
- 40 minute breaks after each session
- 2.30 pm Walk back to Town Hall station Platform 2
- 3.02 pm train to depart Town Hall to return to Richmond
- Arrive 4.24 pm
- Move to McDonalds car park for collection
