ABORIGINAL DARUG CULTURE BREWONGLE EEC EXCURSION

On Friday 17 June, Grose View Public School students who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander will be visiting Brewongle EEC to take part in a Cultural Awareness program. Travel to and from Brewongle will be by bus. Students will take part in the following activities:

- Aboriginal Artefacts & Culture (Wisdom Tree with Cultural Educator): students will learn about a variety of artefacts and their traditional names and uses
- **Bush Resource Walk:** students will take a walk through the forest and discover a variety of bush tucker, medicine, and resource plants.
- Ochre Painting: students will experience the rich colours of ochre and learn traditional Aboriginal symbols
- Sand Art Story: students will watch a story come to life on canvas using coloured sands and traditional Aboriginal symbols

When: Friday 17 June 2022

Cost: No cost. The excursion cost of \$40 per students will be covered by the school.

Times: Bus will depart school at 9.00 am and return by 3.00 pm

Please return the completed permission slip below no later than Friday 3 June 2022.

Students will be expected to wear school uniform and bring a "low litter" recess and lunch. A low litter lunch has: sandwiches/roll/wrap in an air-tight container or re-usable wrap (eg beeswax wrap); drink in a re-usable drink bottle and fruit (mulchable). These should be packed in a re-usable lunch box or recyclable paper bag.
