Grose View Character Parade and Book Week Open Day Wednesday 24 August

12.15	Students and families assembly under COLA (dancers prepare in costume).
12.20	Teacher Reading Relay. Join the students as they choose a teacher to read stories. We will have three 10 minutes sessions.
12.50	Assemble for Open Day assembly
1.00	Story Dance & Choir Display. Enjoy performances from our Stage 1 dance group, Stage 2-3 dance group, and School Choir. Our groups will be performing at the Hawkesbury Performing Arts Festival.
1.25 – 1.55	Family Picnic. School Canteen closed. Lunch orders only through Flexischools by 9:30 am. Book Fair open. Students must be accompanied by an adult.
2:00	Students return to class. Book Fair closes and packed up.
