DRESS: Full school uniform

REQUIREMENTS: Students need to bring writing materials, a packed recess, lunch and a hat. There will be no access to canteen facilities.

PLEASE NOTE: There are no activities for parents on this day. **Please do NOT be late for pick up as the school cannot be accessed after 2:10 pm due to intense bus activity.** (Please be parked waiting at 2 pm in the car park near the bus bays at the front of the school. Colo High School finishes at 2:20 pm.)

Year 6 students CANNOT attend without parental supervision. Colo High School cannot have a duty of care for students not yet attending our school. Primary teachers are not required to attend. Students should wear their usual school uniform.
