HAWKESBURY PERFORMING ARTS FESTIVAL REMINDER – STAGE 1 AND STAGE 2/3 DANCE GROUPS AND CHOIR

The Stage 1 and Stage 2/3 Dance Groups and the Choir will be performing at the Hawkesbury Performing Arts Festival on **Tuesday 6 September 2022**.

On Tuesday 6 September, we have a dress rehearsal for the festival. We will be departing school at 9.00 am and returning at approximately 2.30 pm. **All groups will need to arrive at school by 8.00 am to meet their teachers, change into their costumes and complete make-up and hair.** The children are to leave their school uniform in a labelled plastic shopping bag in their classrooms. Children should bring a school jacket to wear over their costume when travelling to and from the rehearsal. A small bag containing a water bottle with a packed recess and lunch will also be required.

After the rehearsal the groups will be returning to school to change back into their uniform. Please ensure that all of your child's school uniform is clearly labelled.

Children will be travelling from school by bus for the dress rehearsal. **Students are expected to make their own way to Windsor High School for the Tuesday evening performance.** Each group will **meet at 6.20 pm** outside the hall. Specific details will be given after the rehearsal. Students are to be picked up from Mrs Hopkins, Mrs Stone or Mrs O'Rourke at the conclusion of the performance at approximately 9.00 pm. Students are not permitted to leave early as we will be waiting in the holding rooms.

If you purchased a ticket for the Hawkesbury Performing Arts Festival it will be attached to this note. **The yellow program is the ticket** and will need to be shown to gain access to the Hall.

Please contact the school office should your child not be able to attend the performance.

Stage 1 Dance Group

Please ensure your child's hair is in a slicked bun. No makeup is required but plain lip gloss and blush is allowed. Grooming as per Synergy. Students will take their costumes home in the afternoon to wear to the performance in the evening. All costumes need to be returned to school on Wednesday.

Stage 2-3 Dance Group

Hair and make-up as per Synergy and Wakakirri.

Please tie your child's hair in a low ponytail. Each student will be supplied with a green ribbon to wear as a hairband. All students are to wear black leggings/jeans and a plain white T-shirt.
