Our TSA team students act as environmental leaders to educate their peers, share their work with local schools and act on projects with the help from industry experts. Over the past four years, our TSA team has made a positive impact on our school environment. They have investigated wildlife species within our environmental area, provided efficient waste solutions around the school, and managed our school's revegetation program to support the growth of native species and eradicate/control invasive weeds.

With the help of National Parks & Wildlife in 2020, our TSA team were able to begin their revegetation plan through the Junior Rangers project. They were selected as the 2021 Greater Sydney Junior Landcare Team due to the work they had achieved. This year, our K-6 students are revisiting the Junior Rangers program to learn about how they can make a difference within our school environment and learn from the TSA team students.
