STUDENT LEADERSHIP 2023

We are inviting eligible Year 5 students to nominate for a student leadership position in 2023. Eligible candidates may apply for the following positions:

A student leadership role is a very important and highly respected position within the school. The expectations of student leaders are very high and the role can be quite demanding. Students who are nominating for a leadership position will need to consider their suitability for the role and eligibility to nominate.

Eligibility for student leadership

- **A commitment to represent our school** as an exemplary role model. This will include consistent high standards of behaviour, classwork and presentation of school uniform.
- **A willingness to perform all official duties** as required by the teachers and the Principal. This may include public speaking, event organisation, attendance at meetings and participation in special events.
- **A demonstrated consistent effort as a learner** both within and beyond the classroom.
- **An exemplary behaviour record** that reflects a strong commitment to schools values and code of conduct.

Steps in nominating for a student leadership position

- 1 Complete the attached nomination form, with parent signature, and return it to school by **Friday 11 November**.
- 2 Students wishing to nominate for Sports House Captain positions must also apply for Student Leader positions and will be required to perform both speeches.
- 3 Eligible candidates will be notified shortly after.
- 4 Prepare a speech (3 mins max) outlining how you will fulfil the role of student leader.

- School Captains/Vice-Captains/Prefects: **Tuesday 22 November 9.30 am** in the school hall
- Sports House Captains: **Tuesday 22 November 2.00 pm** in sports house meetings

Speech etiquette





Presenters are not permitted to use props or distribute lollies and/or chocolate during speech presentations. Sports House Captains candidates may wear sport uniforms, but all other speeches must be delivered in full school uniform. Respect must be shown to all candidates before, during and after speeches.

Students may only hold one student leadership position, but are entitled to stand for all available positions. The induction of student leaders for 2023 will be announced on **Wednesday 7 December 2022**. The announcement will be made on Presentation Day, however, we are unsure of how this will go ahead at the moment.

Parents and Carers are invited to attend the 9:30 am speech presentations in the hall.
