<b>Description:</b>	<p>Your child will be participating in the Hawkesbury PSSA Netball Gala Day on Friday 1 September. There will be one mixed senior (Stage 3) team and one mixed junior (Stage 2) team participating in this event.</p> <p>Students will also have training sessions during recess and lunch times.</p>
<b>Venue:</b>	Windsor Netball Courts (162 Mileham Street, South Windsor)
<b>Transport:</b>	<p>Private vehicle.</p> <p>Your child will need to be at Windsor Netball Courts by 9.00 am and be collected at approximately 2.30 pm.</p> <p>If you're unable to take or pick up your own child from the event or you are able to take other children please let Miss Galea know by contacting the office by Monday 28 August.</p>
<b>Dress Code:</b>	All students are to wear their full school uniform, hat, sunscreen and running shoes.
<b>Food:</b>	Students will need to bring a packed recess, lunch and full water bottle.
<b>Please Bring:</b>	Students need to bring a towel or blanket to sit on.
<b>Additional Information:</b>	<p>Please note that a \$10 per player cash payment for court hire is required via the school office.</p> <p>If behaviour is inappropriate, parents/carers will be contacted to collect their child from the event.</p> <p><b>IMPORTANT INFORMATION</b></p> <p>In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for</p>

compensation.

Parents/carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child/ward's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region and state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child/ward's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the loss of use of certain prescribed parts of the body. #### CONCUSSION CLEARANCE

The Australian Medical Association recommends students being symptom-free of concussion for 14 days before returning to sport. Students who have suffered a concussion with 14 days of the event, must provide written clearance from a medical practitioner prior to participating.

If your child/ward sustains a concussion, or experiences any concussion symptoms, in the 14-day period prior to the event commencing, you must report this to team officials, and a medical clearance is required in order for your child/ward to participate in the event.

Medical clearances can be sent to the school office separately.
