## **Orientation Day**

Dear Year 6 Parents and Caregivers,

We hope that your children have enjoyed the Transition activities we have offered thus far, we have thoroughly enjoyed getting to meet our new students and look forward to them joining us in 2024!

As Head Teacher of Transition here at Colo High, I would like to extend an invitation to all our new students and their parents/carers to our Orientation Day this year.

**When:** 28<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Please arrive with your child at 8:30 for an 8:45am start. The day will conclude at 11:30am.

\*Please note all Year 6 students must be in the care of a parent/adult. Primary school teachers will not be attending on the day, nor will Colo HS staff provide supervision (outside of programmed activities).

Where: Colo High School Hall and Theatrette.

\*Note that parking at our site is limited, so car-pooling is encouraged. We will have some space:

- In the 'Gravel Pit' on Bells Line of Rd (walk down to school site via footpath).
- Down the left-hand side of our driveway.
- In the gravel parking area down the left-hand side of the school (shared with staff and students)
- In the bus bay area (only once all buses have departed, usually after 8:05)

Once you have parked, please grab your information pack (alphabetically ordered) from our student leaders at the front of the school & head down into the Hall.

## Overview:

This day provides invaluable information about Colo High & Year 7 for both students and their parents. The day will begin with a formal assembly in the Hall followed by two alternate parent sessions, 'BYOD Requirements', & 'Getting Organised for High School'. Students will be taken for separate Peer Support activities and to the library for a library card/profile photo.

- Please ensure you bring any medical plans if your child has a diagnosis of Asthma, Epilepsy, Diabetes, or anything that requires an ASCIA plan. One of our SASS will be on hand in the Hall to collect these.
- ID photos of your child will be taken to provide them with a Library/ID card early in Term 1.
