Stage 2 (3L and 3/4D)	Stage 2 will be running a Haunted House. Jobs will include selling tickets at the door, looking after the safety of children in the haunted house, maintaining decorations and most importantly scaring the children.
Stage 3 (4/5S, 5/6L and 5/6S)	Stage 3 will be running a Side Show Alley on the back oval. Jobs will include running games, selling tickets for games, spray painting hair, painting nails and giving out prizes.
