In Week 8 of Term 2 you will receive a Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ). This will help determine if your child may benefit from further support in regards to their behaviour, emotions, hyperactivity, social skills and helpful behaviour skills.

When you return your form your child's teacher will also complete one to assess your child's development in the classroom and you will receive a letter regarding the results.

If concerns are raised for your child we will also try to contact you by telephone so that we can link you to further supports should you wish.

Nervous or clingy in new situations, easily loses confidence

Often lies or cheats			
Picked on or bullied by other children			
Often offers to help others (parents, teachers, other children)			
Thinks things out before acting			
Steals from home, school or elsewhere			
Gets along better with adults than with other children			
Many fears, easily scared			
Good attention span, sees chores or homework through to the end
